Abraham and Faith

Faith – Hearing a report from God and then acting upon it.

Abrahamic Covenant involved the land, the seed and the blessing.

- The Covenant was introduced to Abraham before he was a follower of God. (Gen. 12:1-9)
- The Covenant was made with Abraham without any conditions for him to fulfill. (Gen. 15:18-21)
- The Covenant was reaffirmed with Abraham before the sign of circumcision. (Gen. 17:1-14)
- Abraham's faith in the covenant-making God was proven by his willingness to sacrifice. (Gen. 22:1-19)

Isa 51:1-2 "Listen to me, you who pursue righteousness, you who seek the LORD: look to the rock from which you were hewn, and to the quarry from which you were dug. 2 Look to Abraham your father and to Sarah who bore you; for he was but one when I called him, that I might bless him and multiply him."

Abraham was justified by faith, not works (vs. 1-17a).

If by works, there is a reason for pride (v. 2).

If by works, we are owed something (v. 4).
