Through Christ, we have...

- Peace with God (v. 1).
- Access to Him (v. 2a).

Eph. 2:18; 3:12; Heb. 10:19-22; John 14:6

- Hope because of His love (vs. 2b-5).
- Grace clearly shown to us (vs. 6-8).
- Assurance of His salvation (v. 9).
- A reconciled relationship with God (vs. 10-11).

Reconciliation= lit. "to exchange" It is a metaphor from the realm of battle.

"A restoring of a relationship to a former state."

Col. 1:19; 2 Cor. 5:18-21

Through Adam...

- Sin came into the world (v.12a).
- Death came by sin (v. 12a).
- All sinned in him (Adam) (v. 12b-14).

Through Christ, Adam's sin is overcome (vs. 15-19).
